Thank you for the opportunity to submit on the proposal to install an electronic billboard on the roof of 2 Jervois Quay.

We oppose the proposal in its current form for the following reasons:

SR513399

- Incompatibility with the character of the building and Post Office Square
- Dominance effect
- Contrary to the objectives and policies in the District Plan and inconsistent with the Design Guide for Signs in the District Plan

#### Integration with the building and site

- We acknowledge the detailed history and description of the building as outlined as part of the heritage assessment by archifact (and originally published on wellingtoncityheritage.org.nz).
- The assessment of environmental effects as part of the heritage assessment states that as the billboard will be 'clearly separate and legibly unrelated from the Chicago-style architectural detailing' the proposed billboard it will not detract from the architecture of the building. We consider that, as the billboard is proposed on the roof of the building this will be read as one and that the billboard will be read as an element of the building that is in contrast with its existing character.
- We disagree with the statement that the proposed billboard does not detract from the character of the building as signage was already established on the building in 1963. We consider that the style, technology and illumination of the original billboards cannot be compared to the current proposal. As the original signage was visually permeable and non-digital it better fitted with the Chicago-style architecture of the building at the time.
- We consider that the photomontages in the application document do not give an accurate representation of the actual end result. A digital billboard in this location will most likely require a deeper depth to accommodate the electronics as well as additional flashing to the sides, which will have further impact on the visibility and integration with the façade.
- We acknowledge that the dimensions and placement of the proposed billboard appear to approximately align with the window pattern in the front façade. However, we consider that this does

not mitigate the incompatibilities of the proposed billboard with the host building, in terms of lighting (and potential colours of advertising), size and material.

Dominance in the street scape and loss of visual amenity

- Post Office Square marks a gateway into a more people focused area of the city and acts as an
  intersection of pedestrian movements (between the city and the railway station and between the
  centre and the waterfront due to its connection with Queens Wharf) and is in itself a popular
  coffee/lunch spot. The heritage buildings along two of its edges reinforce this human scale character.
- We consider that the architectural style of the Huddart Parker building brings a significant contribution to the character of Post Office Square. The height of the Huddart Parker building, as a landmark feature on the square, strikes a comfortable balance with the dimensions of the square. A solid luminous billboard on the roof of this building would effectively increase the height of the building, which would have an adverse effect on the perception of comfort and human scale-effect that the building has on the Square and detract from the character and visual amenity as it is currently perceived when travelling along Jervois Quay from the north.
- The above effects are contrary to the objectives and policies, and Design Guide for Signs in the District Plan.

Overall, we seek the current consent application be declined. We could accept signage in this location if it was better aligned with the character of the Huddart Parker building and did not dominate the street scape.
