I am writing to express my support for the Wilsons site on the corner of Ghuznee and Leeds St remaining a carpark long term.

We have run our Fortune Favours Brew pub for the last 7 ½ years from our location at 7 Leeds St. During that time we have experienced first hand the role that the carpark plays in supporting the local businesses. There is only minimal street parking in the immediate area so the Wilson carpark plays a significant role in ensuring that customers have somewhere to park. They have also allowed us to build a covered bike park within their carpark which our staff and customers use.

As there is already a lot of traffic activity on Ghuznee & Leeds St, the Wilsons carpark plays an important role in providing a quiet space on the street and minimised a potential pressure point which we feel improves street safety.

As one of the immediate neighbours of the Wilsons carpark we find them easy to work with and they have always supported local business when it comes to pop up offerings such as Gorilla Burger & other pop up food truck offerings. They also support Cuba Dupa where they allow the entire space to be used for a family entertainment area.
