December Protests

Thank you for your request made under the Local Government Official Information and Meetings Act 1987 (the Act), received on 20 December 2022. You requested the following information:

1. All communications, reports, documentation, notes, and all other relevant information and material, in relation to any, and all; orders, requests, operations, commands, complaints, and anything else that may be relevant to the Wellington City Council, and its members/employees, involvement with the protests that occurred on the 13th, 14th, and 15th of December, 2022, at Parliament House and why they were involved.
2. The Parking Tickets/Infringements made along Molesworth St, and any/all communications, information and documentation in relation to the dates mentioned above.
3. Why orange traffic control cones were still blocking the parking outside of Parliament grounds after the 13th of December and after the Black Ferns event had ended?
4. Clarify why the Wellington Police Department assisted two parking wardens in giving out invalid parking tickets, why this was deemed necessary, who directed this operation to occur, and why. I would also like all relevant communications, documentation meetings notes, and all other relevant information and material in relation to this matter.

Wellington City Council has granted your request for information. Please see the below response to your request.

1. **All communications, reports, documentation, notes, and all other relevant information and material, in relation to any, and all; orders, requests, operations, commands, complaints, and anything else that may be relevant to the Wellington City Council, and its members/employees, involvement with the protests that occurred on the 13th, 14th, and 15th of December 2022, at Parliament House and why they were involved.**

Below are the documents that fall in scope of your request and my decision to release the document. Any redactions made are for privacy reasons under section 7(2)(a) of the Act including contact details and vehicle licence plate numbers. These documents are attached to your request.

2. The Parking Tickets/Infringements made along Molesworth St, and any/all communications, information and documentation in relation to the dates mentioned above.

If someone does not pay for parking in a metered space, they are liable to receive a \$40 parking ticket. If they stay too long in a metered space or in a time restricted space, they will receive a parking ticket with a fee depending on the time overstayed.

If someone parks in a way that's unsafe for pedestrians or other vehicles, they will receive a \$60 fee. Most other parking infringements incur a \$40 fee. This includes parking on footpaths. Some offences incur a \$150 fee, such as parking in an area reserved for disabled people.

We allow a one calendar month grace period for vehicle owners to renew their Warrant of Fitness and vehicle licence (registration) after the date of expiry. After this period, if the vehicle is unwarranted or unlicensed, a \$200 fee will be issued.

If an infringement is not paid within 28 days a reminder notice is sent which allows for a further 28 days to pay the infringement. I have not included these reminder notices in the correspondence, as these are a generic response.

Below is a summary of the 52 infringements issued on Molesworth Street between 13-15 December. Please note this includes all tickets made on Molesworth Street on the days requested and will include tickets not relating to the protest.

3. Why were orange traffic control cones still blocking the parking outside of Parliament grounds after the 13th of December and after the Black Ferns event had ended?

Parking was reserved on Molesworth Street, Kate Sheppard Place and some parts of Thorndon Quay to allow for treaty settlement readings at parliament. This was approved via a Traffic Management Plan (TMP) submitted by the office for Māori Crown relations.

4. Clarify why the Wellington Police Department assisted two parking wardens in giving out invalid parking tickets, why this was deemed necessary, who directed this operation to occur, and why.

Police contacted Wellington City Council on Tuesday 13 December to advise of cars parked on the footpath which required towing and to ticket any vehicles as required (document five).

Police again contacted WCC on Wednesday 14 December via text to advise of further parking issues which needed addressing.

On Thursday 15 December WCC received a request from Police regarding a bus parked in a mobility space on Ballance Street, near Molesworth Street. The bus left the park without needing a ticket, however officers then ticketed other vehicles nearby as required.

The texts between the Parking Services Team Leader and Police are attached (item 6). Any other discussions took place over the phone to coordinate the timing of officers and to make sure the protest site was safe to ticket. The nature of this communication was administrative regarding timing, contact details for team members and locations of vehicles.

Police confirmed that they could provide support to ensure the safety of parking officers while in attendance. During the February occupation of Parliament parking staff were subject to abuse and threats from protesters, as such we take the safety of our Parking Officers during protests very seriously.

To clarify part of your request, the tickets are valid. Offences are controlled by the following pieces of legislation:

- Land Transport Act 1998
- Land Transport (Road User) Rule 2004
- Traffic and Parking Bylaw 2021
- Maximum fees a council can charge are set out in the Land Transport (Offences and Penalties) Regulations 1999.

Tickets can be issued in situations such as when someone:

- doesn't pay for parking
- overstays the time limit
- parks unsafely – for example, on broken yellow lines or on the footpath
- parks a vehicle on a road with an expired warrant of fitness or licence label.

It is currently thought that the protest will if it goes ahead in fact start after the Black Ferns public event in the precinct. They will meet again on Monday to update.

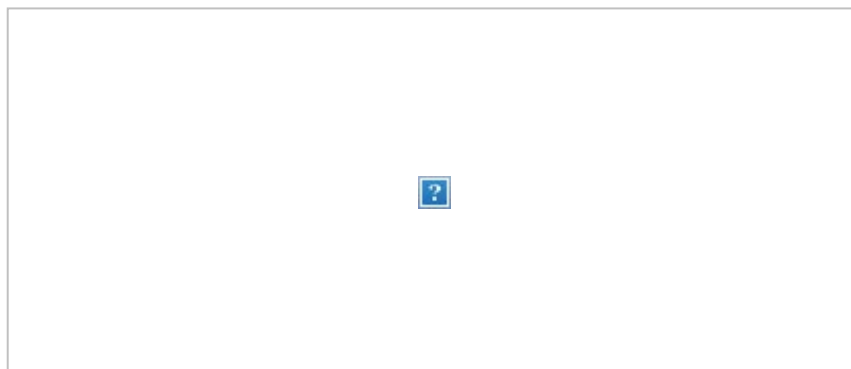
