

1 January 2025	The inspectorate observed too many people queuing outside Shady Lady and
	Vinyl Bar resulting inspectorate walking on road in order to pass the crowd.
2 July 2025	Report from Senior Sergeant spoke to Police Service Unit staff who regularly
	patrol Courtenay Place late nights, and they said that the parklet area outside
	Shady Lady is used regularly as just a storage area for the premises and they
	have had concerns about the space for some time.
23 May 2025	Reports that the Parklet outside Vinyl bar is not being used much and full or
	rubbish.
NA	Vinyl Bar had their queue set up on the roadside with people walking
	through the foot traffic to get into the bar – felt chaotic.
NA	Vinyl Bar – main issue area – crowded footpath, line management.
