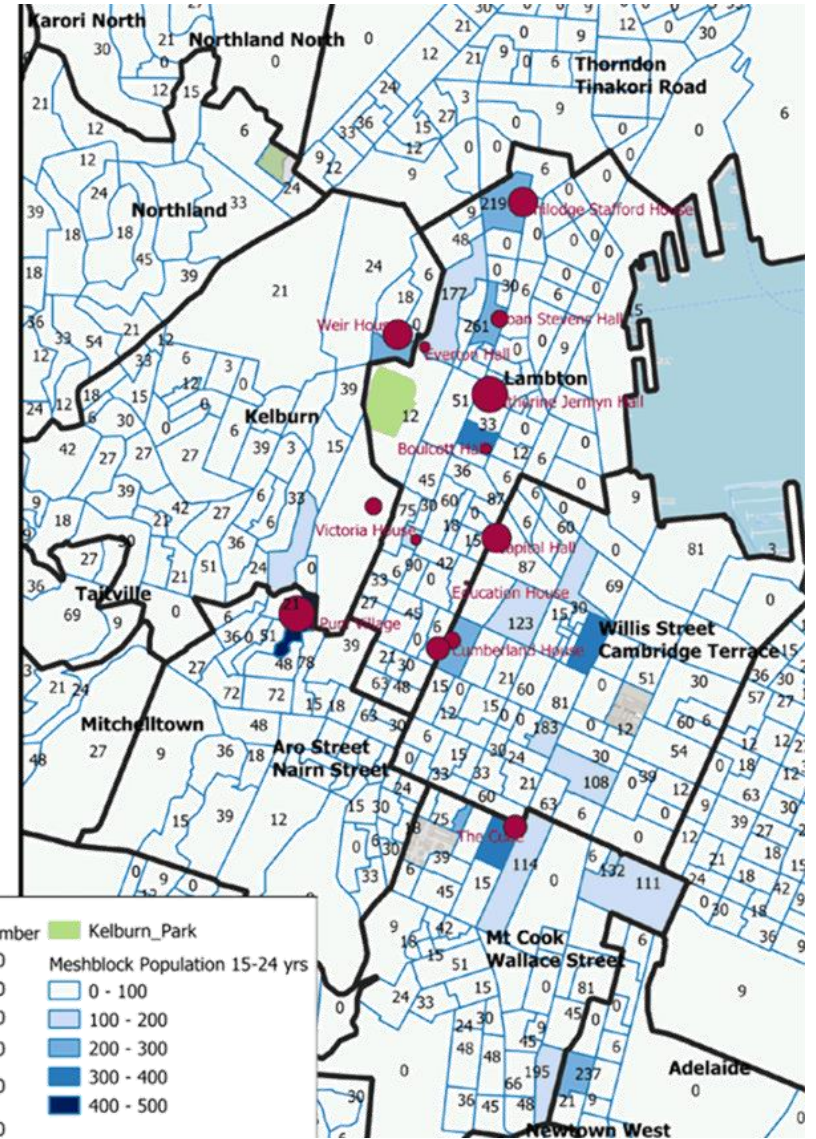

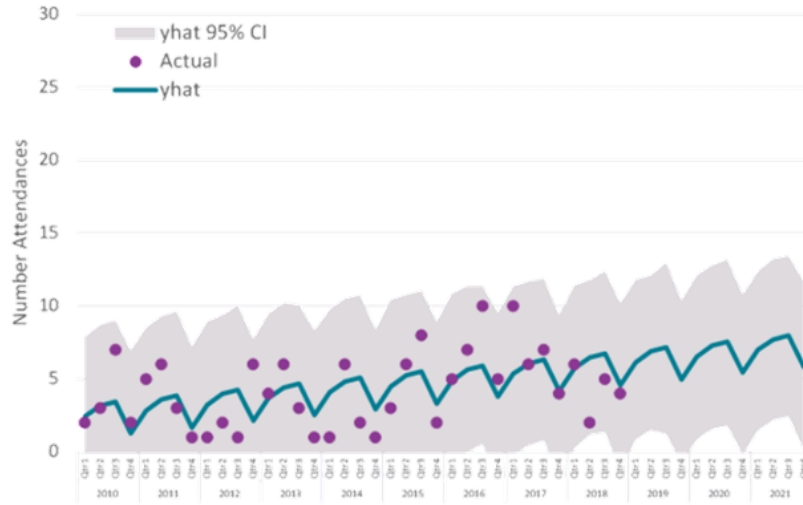

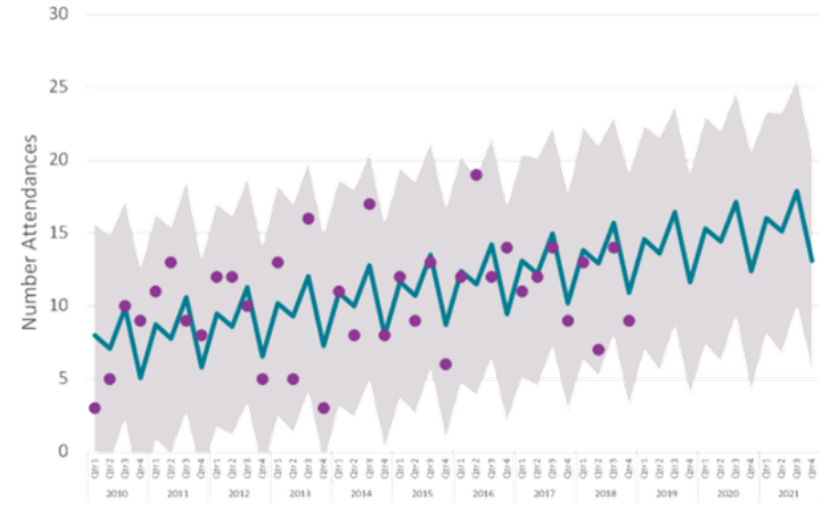

18-24yrs – Quarterly Forecast

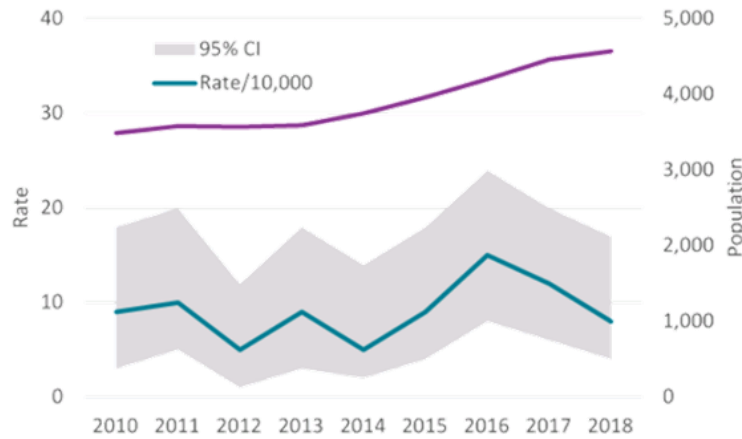

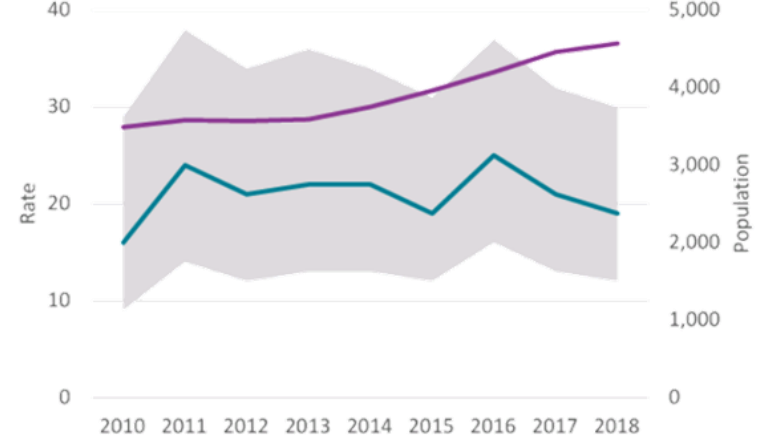


15-24yrs – Yearly Trend

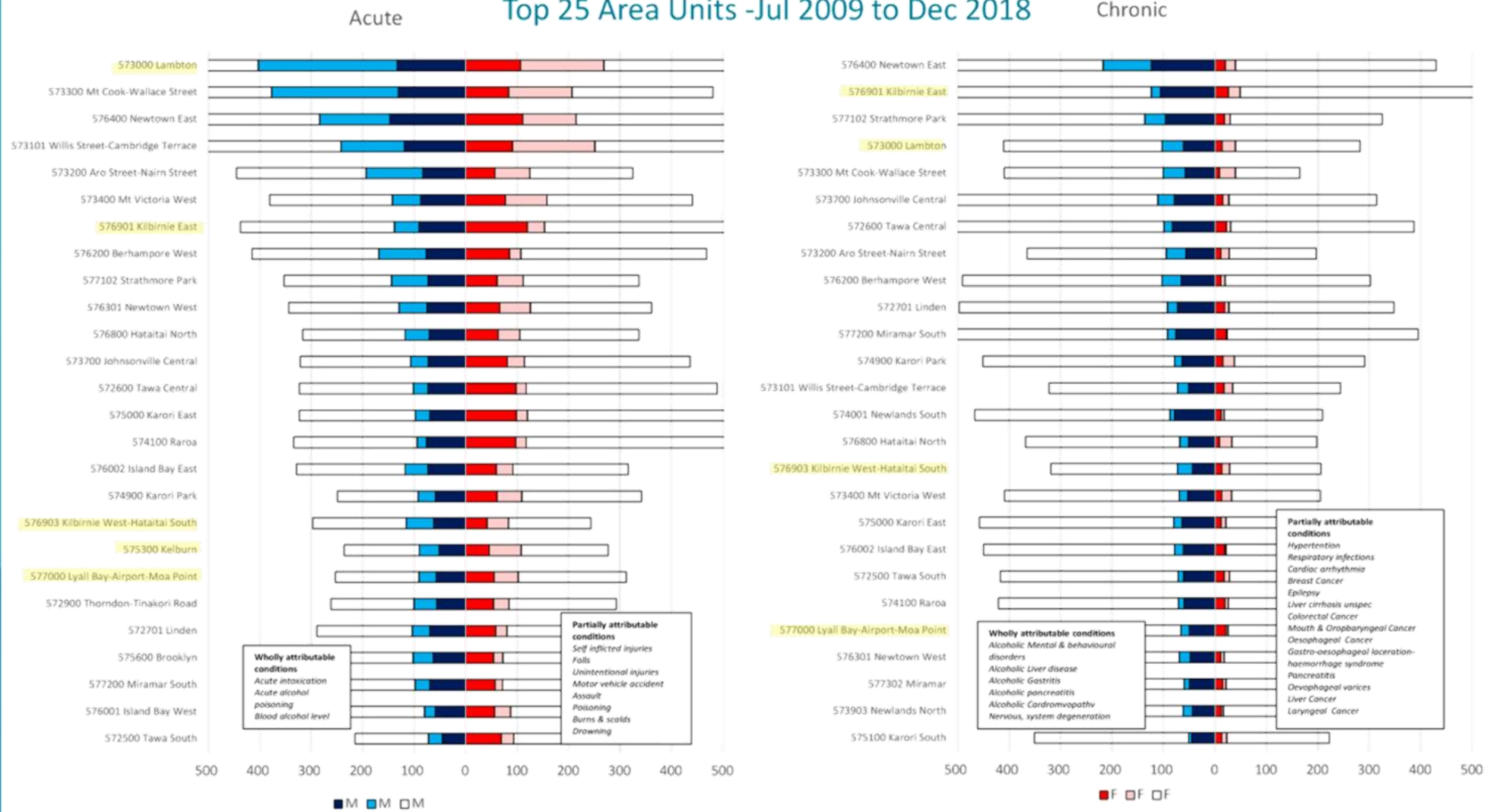
