The premise of changing the Curtis Street to a Business Area is fundamentally flawed. I believe that erecting large buildings on the site will have a serious effect on the ecological corridor that exists between Zealandia and Otari Wilton bush. The proposed re-zoning and anticipated construction of a large retail complex at this narrow part of the corridor will limit the extent of the wild life recovery we are currently witnessing.
