



**Te Wharangi Ridge (northwest side)**

- Prominent skyline landform in rural landscape
- Landmarks: British Peak and Makara Peak
- Open pasture-covered summit land with regenerating vegetation or plantation forestry on rugged flanks.

**Te Wharangi Ridge (southeast side)**

- Prominent skylines and green backdrop seen from central city and western suburbs
- Landmarks: Johnston Hill and Makara Peak
- Consistent pattern of pasture-covered summit land above forested or revegetating flanks

**Tinakori Hill**

- Landmark skyline seen from central city and western suburbs
- Vegetated green backdrop to central city

**Wrights Hill**

- Landmark flat-topped hill
- Prominent skyline feature and green backdrop seen from central city and western suburbs
- Native forest and regenerating vegetation developing on flanks and parts of summit.

**Te Kopahau Ridge**

- Rugged skyline and hill backdrop seen from central city and eastern suburbs
- Landmark : Polhill wind turbine
- Vegetation regenerating on steep flanks and parts of the summit land.
