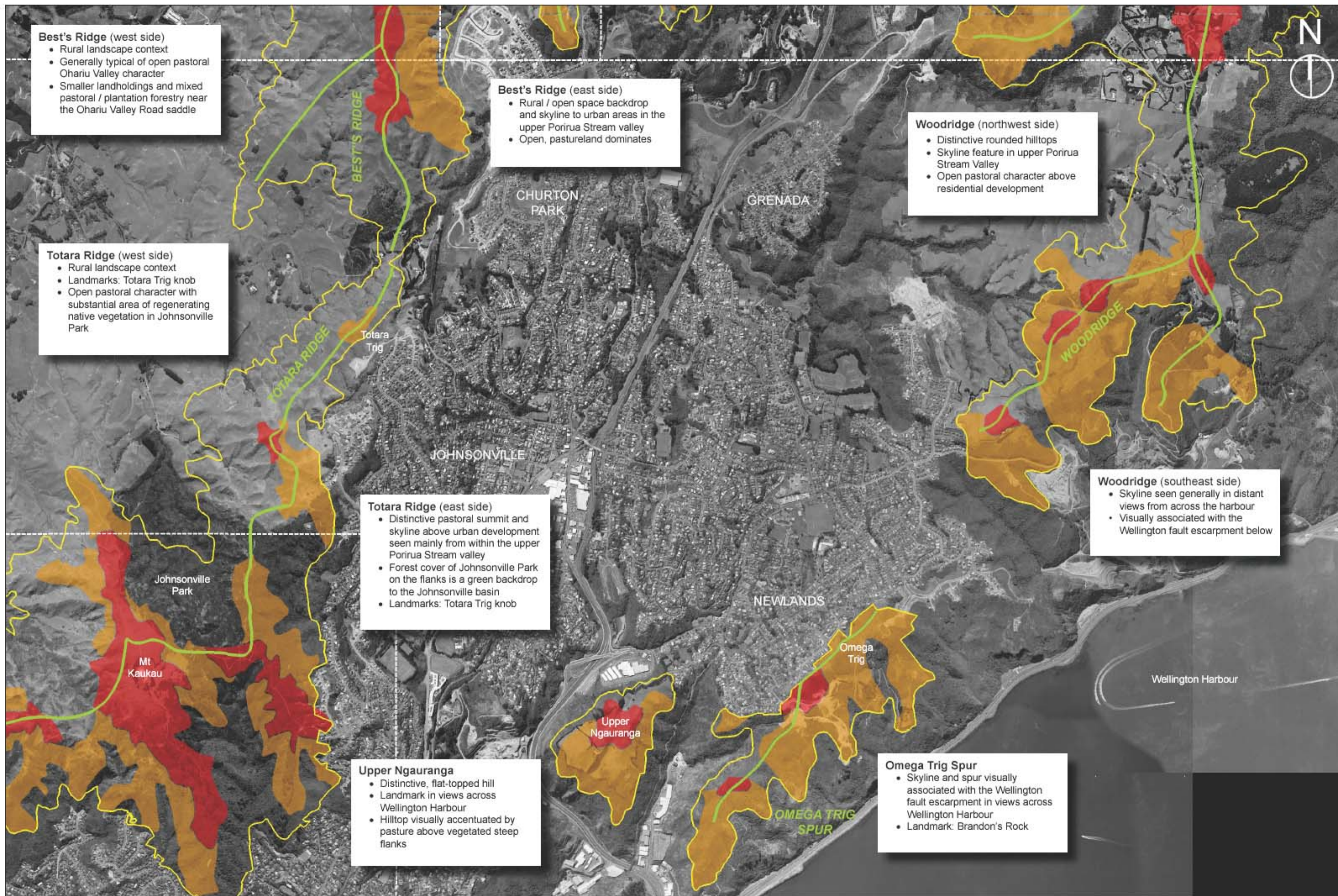
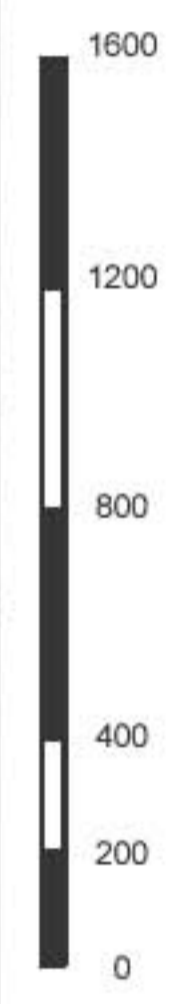

Best's Ridge (west side)

- Rural landscape context
- Generally typical of open pastoral Ohariu Valley character
- Smaller landholdings and mixed pastoral / plantation forestry near the Ohariu Valley Road saddle

Best's Ridge (east side)

- Rural / open space backdrop and skyline to urban areas in the upper Porirua Stream valley
- Open, pastureland dominates

Woodridge (northwest side)

- Distinctive rounded hilltops
- Skyline feature in upper Porirua Stream Valley
- Open pastoral character above residential development

Totara Ridge (west side)

- Rural landscape context
- Landmarks: Totara Trig knob
- Open pastoral character with substantial area of regenerating native vegetation in Johnsonville Park

Totara Ridge (east side)

- Distinctive pastoral summit and skyline above urban development seen mainly from within the upper Porirua Stream valley
- Forest cover of Johnsonville Park on the flanks is a green backdrop to the Johnsonville basin
- Landmarks: Totara Trig knob

Woodridge (southeast side)

- Skyline seen generally in distant views from across the harbour
- Visually associated with the Wellington fault escarpment below

Upper Ngauranga

- Distinctive, flat-topped hill
- Landmark in views across Wellington Harbour
- Hilltop visually accentuated by pasture above vegetated steep flanks

Omega Trig Spur

- Skyline and spur visually associated with the Wellington fault escarpment in views across Wellington Harbour
- Landmark: Brandon's Rock
