INF-P6	Neutral	Transpower is interested in the outcome of this appeal point by the Appellant due to the applicability of INF-P6 to the National Grid (in addition to the INF-NG provisions).
INF-NH-P1	Oppose	Transpower is interested in the relief sought by the Appellant on the basis that the INF-NH subchapter applies to National Grid activities.
		Transpower opposes the relief sought by the Appellant as this could be understood as requiring new infrastructure within Hazard Overlays to minimise the risk from natural hazards. Transpower manages risk on a network basis, and minimising risks to a particular asset may not be appropriate given its location in the network, role it serves and resilience of interconnecting assets.
INF-NH-R3	Support	Transpower is interested in the relief sought by the Appellant on the basis that the INF-NH subchapter applies to National Grid activities.
		Transpower supports those aspects of the relief sought by the Appellant which would result in INF-NH-R3 permitting the maintenance or upgrading of existing above ground infrastructure. These aspects of the relief are consistent with Transpower's approach of managing risk on a network basis.
