Stream 1

1. In Minute 13, we extended the time for the Council's Reply until 30 March.

We have received a Memorandum from Mr McKenzie on behalf of the Council

requesting a further extension by reason of the number and complexity of the

questions the Hearing Panel has posed to the section 42A authors.

2. Four of the Hearing Panel members are involved in the Stream 2 hearing and

will be unable to turn their minds to Stream 1 matters until after those hearings

are complete, at the earliest. A further extension will not, therefore, disrupt

the Hearing Panel's deliberations.

3. In the circumstances, we think it is more valuable that the Council's Reply be

as complete as it can be. We therefore further extend time for the Council's

Stream 1 Reply until 1pm on Friday 14 April.

Stream 2

4. We have had a Memorandum from Counsel for The Retirement Villages

Association and Ryman Healthcare Limited, extending an invitation to the

Hearing Panel, and relevant Council Staff, to tour a retirement village.

5. The Hearing Panel are all familiar with retirement villages both from

professional contacts (as noted in the Stream 1 hearing, Commissioner

McMahon sat as commissioner on the Ryman Healthcare Karori applications)

and personally, through visiting relatives living in retirement villages. We do

not therefore think that we would be materially assisted by a site visit.

6. As above, Counsel's invitation extended to relevant Council Staff. We do not

direct Council Staff to attend a site visit, but they are welcome to take up the

submitters' offer if they wish.
